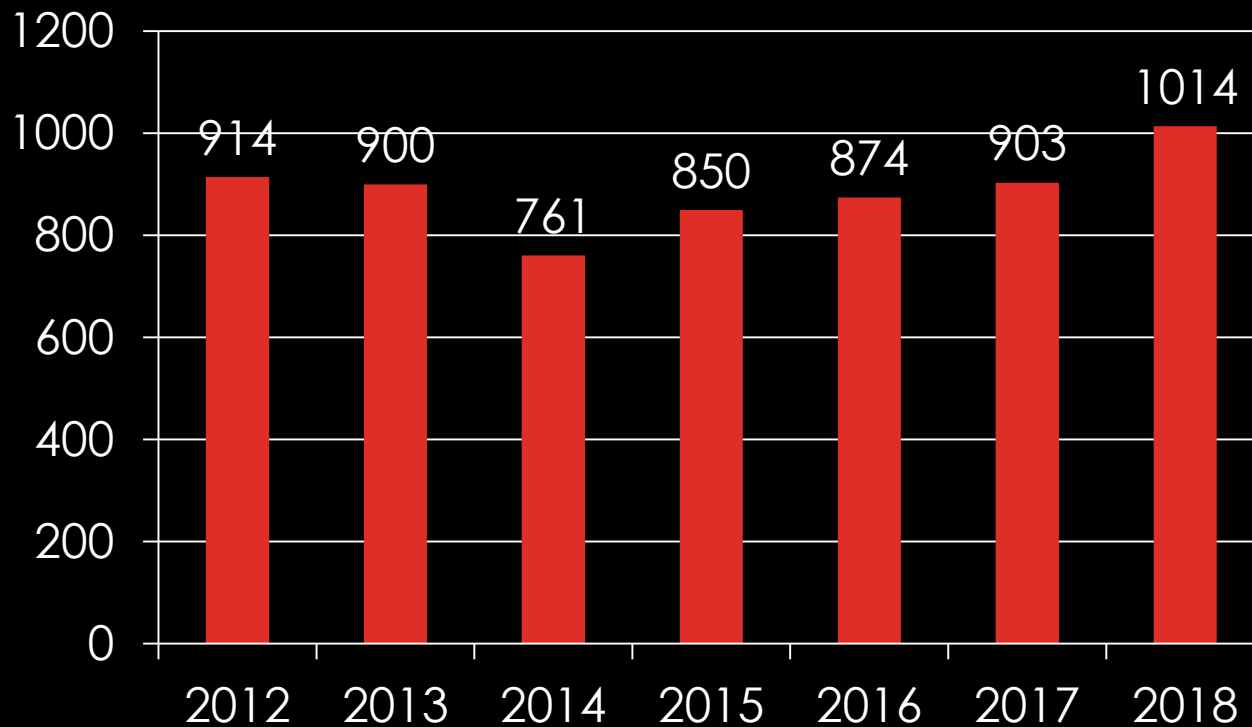

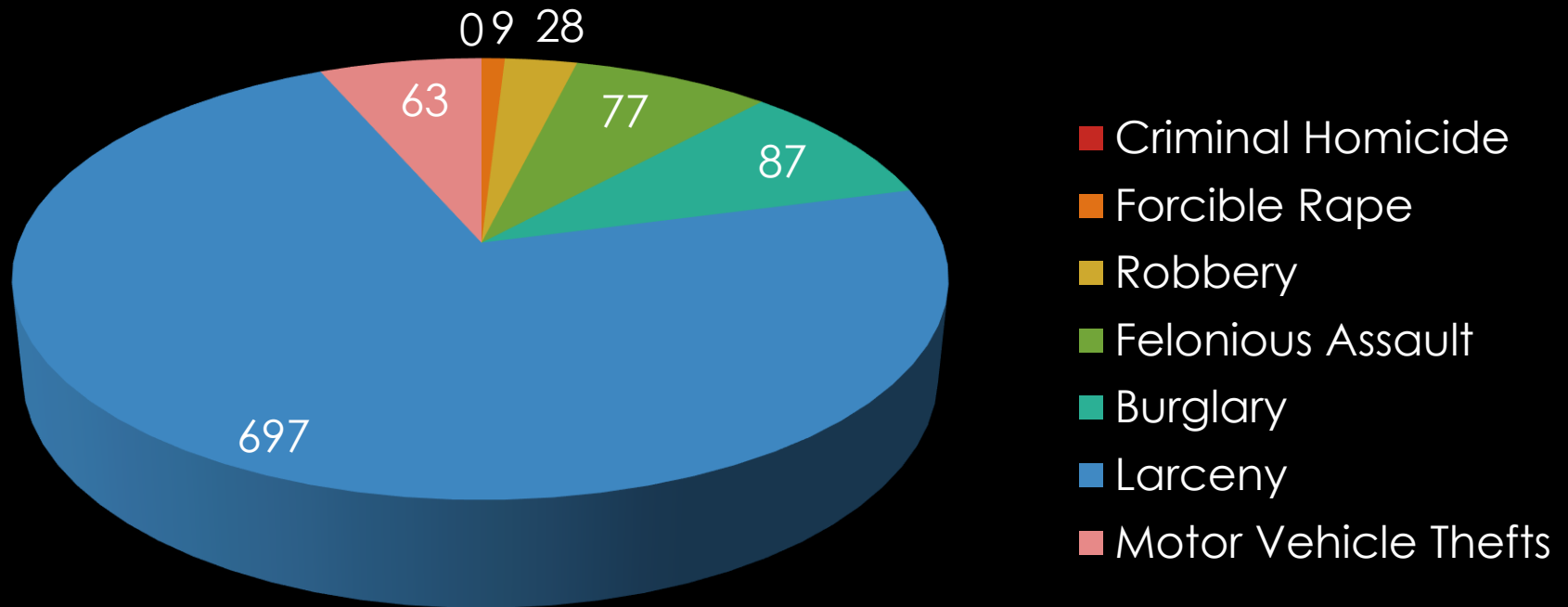

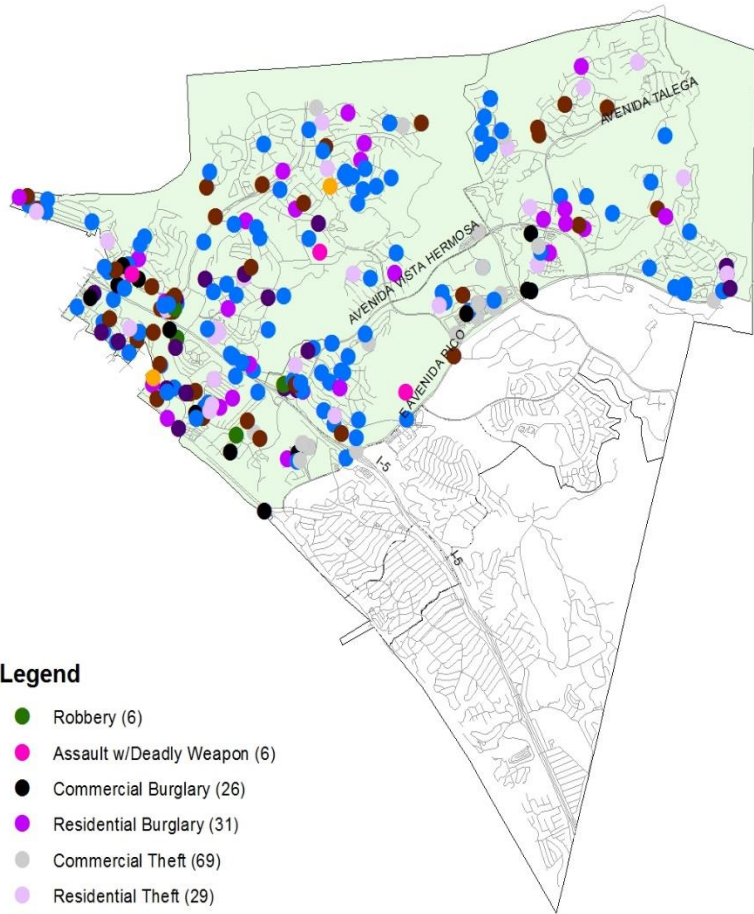

Part 1 Crime



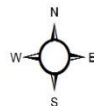
Note: Most Part 1 crimes are theft related.

San Clemente North of Avenida Pico 2018 Criminal Activity

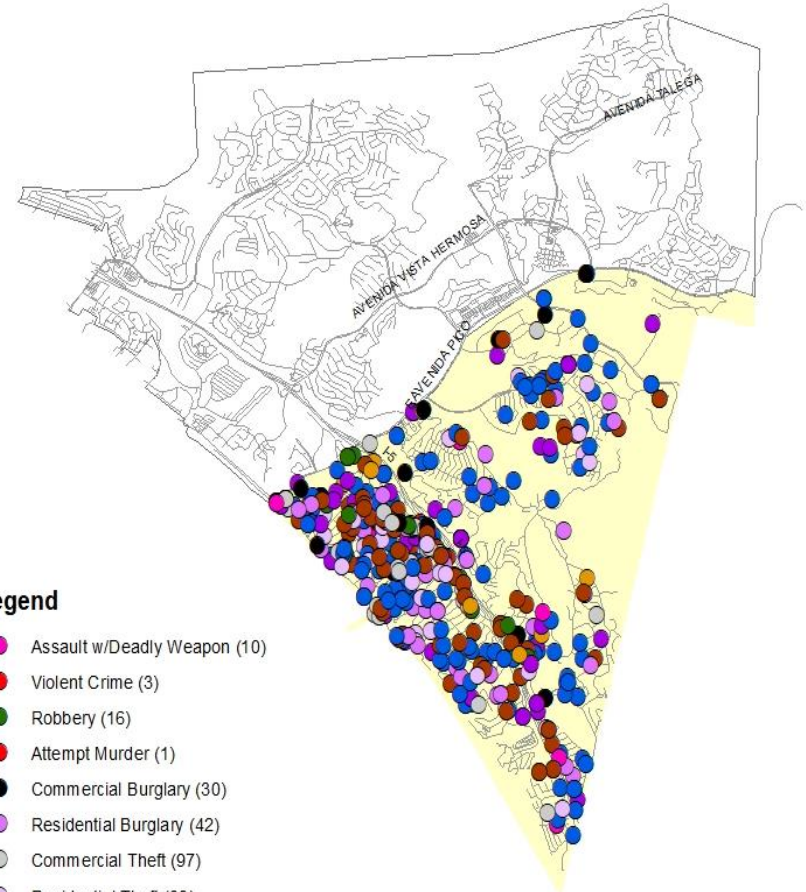

San Clemente South of Avenida Pico 2018 Criminal Activity



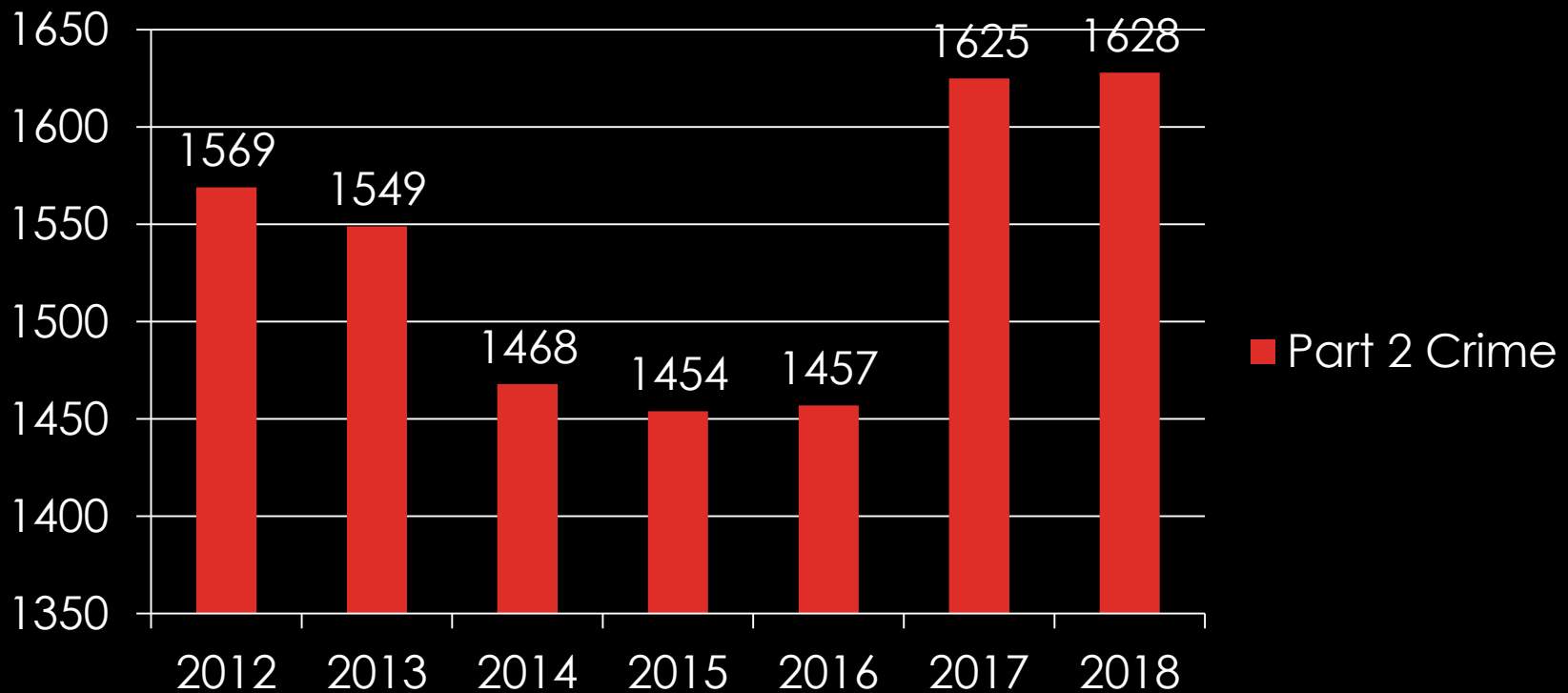

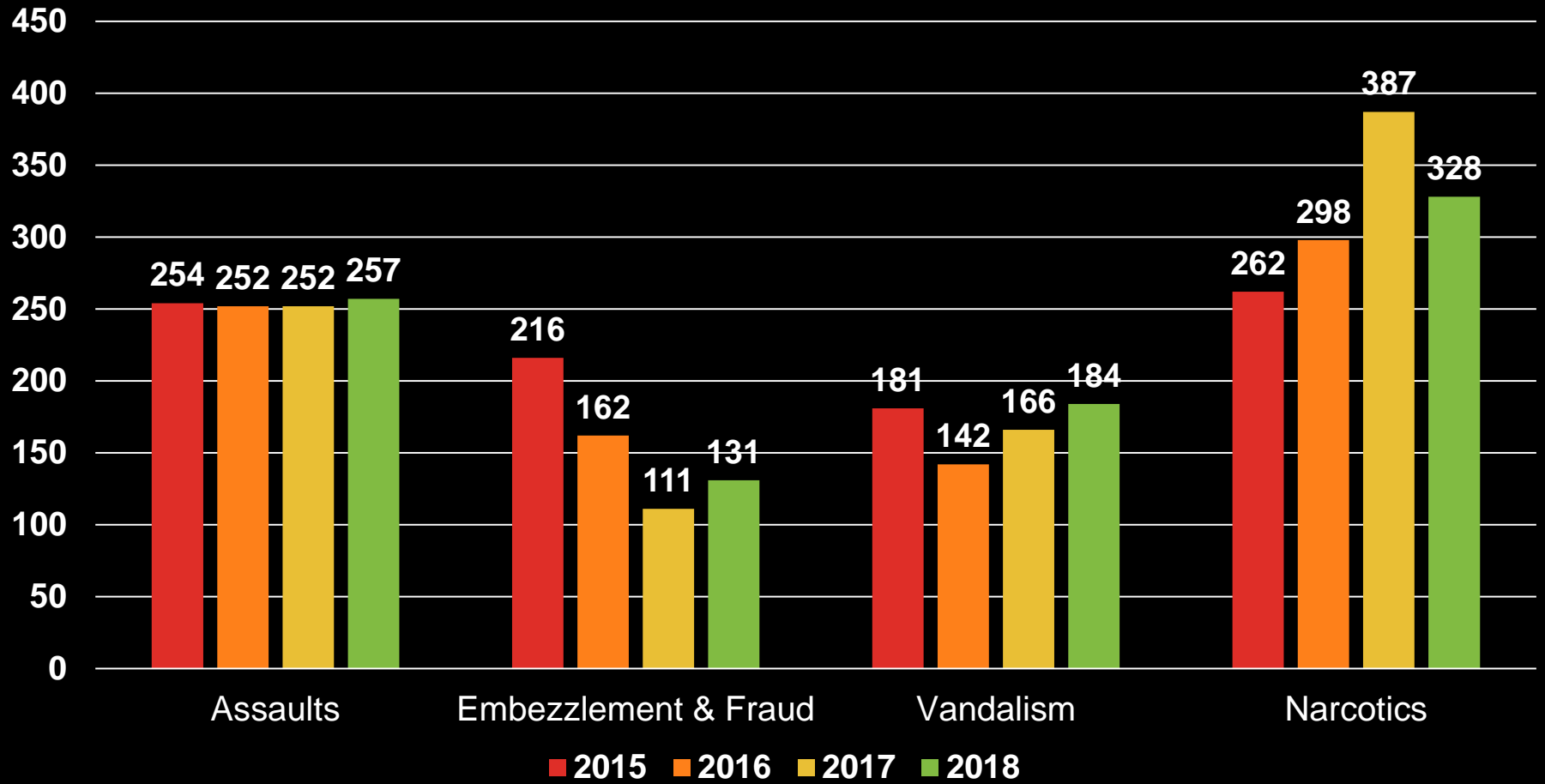

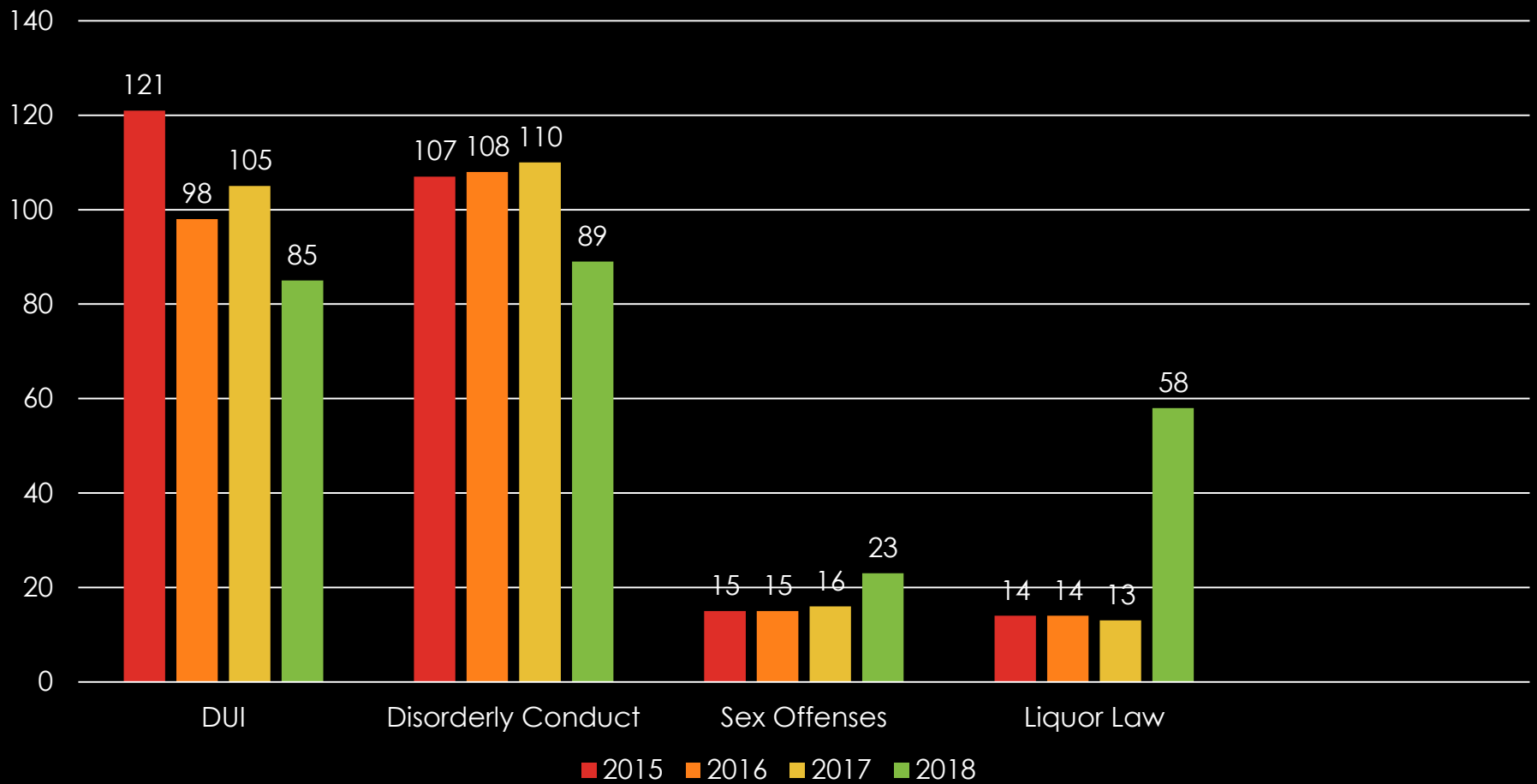

INVESTIGATIONS 2018

- 1709 Cases submitted for review
 - Priority 1 cases: 276
 - Priority 2 cases: 444
 - Priority 3 Cases: 985
 - 201 Cleared
- S/W Operations: 46%
(3,670 Cases)
AV, DP, LN, LH, LW, SJC
- LF: 1334
MV:1461
DP: 973
- Case examples: Assaults, Burglary, Robbery, Theft, Threatening behavior, Court order violations, Drinking in Public, Displaying or Discharging a firearm, Narcotics, Missing People, Vandalism, Etc...
 - All other high priority cases (Sex Crimes, etc...) are investigated by specialty units out of Sheriff's HQ

- Lock your cars and homes

 - Watch who you invite in your house

 - Phone (207)
 - Computer (you have a virus)
 - Donating Money
- Monitor your children's Social Media (and be a good example for them on yours)
